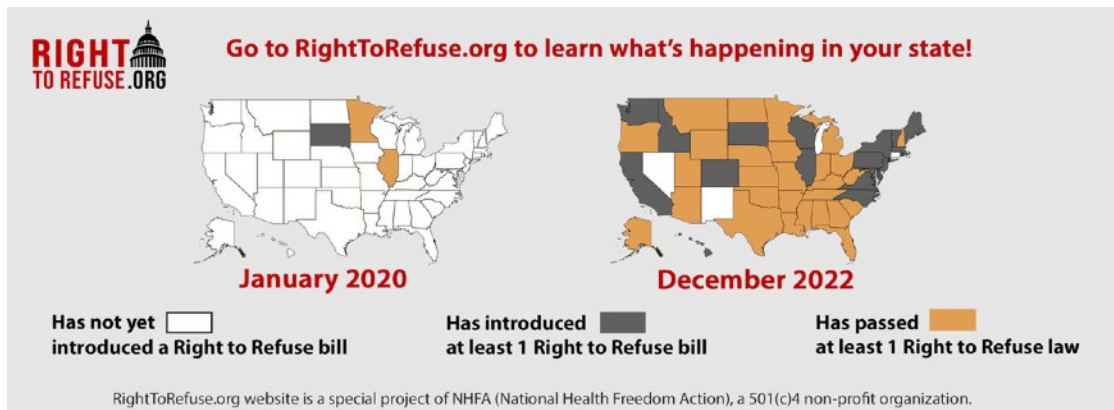




**Health Rights MA**—a volunteer-run, non-profit, 501(c)(4) organization—is promoting legislation to protect fundamental health freedoms in Massachusetts. We are working with attorneys and other health freedom organizations across the country as part of the [Right to Refuse Project](#). Right to Refuse is a national campaign to help state organizations and grassroots advocates connect for the purpose of passing state laws that protect the rights of individuals to make their own health decisions.

**We have already filed 2 bills and are working on filing a 3rd. (Updated 2/3/2023)**

- **FILED! Bodily Autonomy: BILL SD2014 [An Act relative to bodily autonomy and family integrity](#)** — This bill begins “No person shall be compelled by law to acquiesce to medical treatments or procedures, collection of specimens, or sharing of personal data or medical information” Sponsor: Senator Patrick O’Connor. - **FILED! NO COVID vaccine as condition of entry: BILL HD2390** [Representative Peter Durant](#) refiled his bill from the previous session: [An Act prohibiting COVID-19 vaccination as a condition of entry](#). This is an excellent bill that, while limited to the COVID-19 vaccine, would protect **college students** along with everyone else in MA! - **No Genetic Procedures without consent:** We have drafted a bill that would protect people from any mandated medical procedures that could alter human genetics without consent. Health Rights MA is currently seeking a sponsor.

## WHAT CAN YOU DO TO PROTECT HEALTH FREEDOM IN MASSACHUSETTS?

Call both your local REPRESENTATIVE and SENATOR'S offices. If you can't get someone on the phone, you can send an email. Be persistent and polite. Leave a message asking for a callback. If they don't call back within a few days, call again. If they don't email back within a few days, resend the email and put "SECOND REQUEST" at the beginning of the subject line. Be the squeaky wheel!

Via phone or email, explain to your legislators your concerns about government overreach into your life. Tell them you make your own health decisions for yourself and your family, and that won't be changing for you, ever. Tell them no one should be forced to accept a one-size-fits-all, liability-free pharmaceutical product in order to work, to go to school, or simply to live a normal life in Massachusetts. **Tell them your personal story of how you and your family have been negatively affected.**

**Tell them also that you want them to do something about this harmful situation. Ask them if they would be willing to support bills that would protect the rights of the people of Massachusetts to make their own health decisions without coercive tactics. Ask for meeting to discuss this issue.**

The goal of these communications is to start a conversation and develop a relationship with the reps and their staff. Be polite but firm! Follow up with an email and maybe a few links with more information.
